# Dan and Carolyn Pedrotti Endowment for the Center for Sportfish Science and Conservation

(\$2500/semester for 1 year)

The Center for Sportfish Science and Conservation at the Harte Research Institute for Gulf of Mexico Studies offers the Dan and Carolyn Pedrotti Endowment for the Center for Sportfish Science and Conservation. The purpose of the scholarship is to support a top-tier graduate student through tuition and research support in sportfish conservation.

#### Part A: Selection Criteria:

- 1. Student must be currently enrolled as full-time degree-seeking graduate student taking at least 9 credit hours per semester at Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi within the Department of Life Sciences or Department of Physical & Environmental Sciences.
- 2. Student must be pursuing a MS or Ph.D. degree with demonstrated merit on a research project focusing on sportfish and fisheries conservation issues, particularly those aligned with the Center for Sportfish Science and Conservation at the Harte Research Institute.
- 3. Student's research should contribute to the understanding of marine fisheries conservation with emphasis on recreational fishing.
- 4. Selection of the recipient shall consider not only financial need, academic record, but also personal background, description of research focus, career goals, and references.
- 5. Student must be full-time and good standing with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0. Student must not be on scholastic probation or with other official holds on academic records.

  - 2. A brief (2 pg, single-spaced or less) summary of your thesis or dissertation research. If official proposal is already completed, attach that in place of summary.
  - 3. Attach copy(s) of Graduate Transcripts unofficial accepted for initial application.
  - 4. Resume or Curriculum Vitae.
  - 5. Name, phone number, and email address for 3 references.
